Activity for Sergiy's Story

This story focused on the main character learning a foreign language. For this activity, students can research where their ancestors came from and find the words in that language for these words: **friend**, **church**, **family**, **faith**, **kindness**, **grace**, **love**, and **hope**. Those of English descent may want to adopt another language. For those who have ancestors from more than one country, they can choose the one they want. Here are the words in Ukrainian, below that, in Bulgarian, then Romanian, and Greek at the bottom. Helping Hands translates devotions and other materials into 5 languages: Bulgarian, Russian, Greek, Romanian, and Ukrainian.
